Abstract

As the title of the book indicates, the object of study is a number of key 'themes' of Greek history, which were selected on the basis of the research questions posed by the members of the writing team in the context of a scholarly discussion. Our aim is not to publish an overview of the Greek political, diplomatic, economic and, more generally, social history of the Greek state over the course of two centuries - obviously

short, in order to be accommodated in the pages of a single book. On the contrary, from the very first moment, our common intention was the thorough and in-depth analysis of data on historical questions, so that the individual approaches of this book, even if they are not united through a chronologically unified narrative web, highlight the pluralism of theoretical reflection and methodological tools of historical science.
